



Weatherization Works in Florida

Do you need financial assistance to make repairs to your home to improve your energy efficiency? If so, the Weatherization Assistance Program may be able to help. The program, known as WAP and administered by the Florida Department of Community Affairs, provides low-income residents access to federal funds for energy efficiency improvements. This is one of the only programs that can provide services for a mobile home, as well as a site-built dwelling.

To be eligible for WAP services, total household income may not be more than 200% of the federal poverty level. Preference is given to owner-occupied homes, elderly (60 years-plus) or physically disabled residents, families with children under 12 and households with a high energy burden (repeated high utility bills). The program is funded each year by the U.S. Department of Energy (USDOE) and often receives supplemental funding through the Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) which is funded annually through the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services.

Types of Assistance

- Address air infiltration with weather stripping, caulking, thresholds, minor repairs to walls, ceilings and floors, and window and door replacement
- Install attic and floor insulation (floors in northern Florida counties only)
- Install attic ventilation
- Apply solar reflective coating to manufactured homes
- Install solar screens
- Repair or replace inefficient heating and cooling units
- Repair or replace water heaters
